

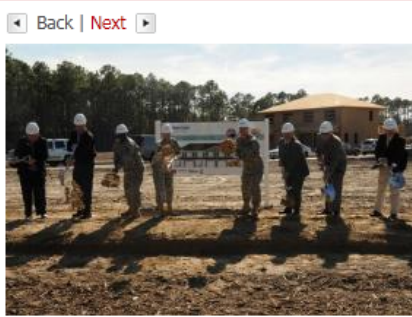

Work begins on homes for 98 junior enlisted families at Hunter Army Airfield

A groundbreaking was held Thursday at Hunter Army Airfield for Hunter Ridge, a new neighborhood that will consist of 98 homes for junior enlisted families.

Representatives from Balfour Beatty Communities, who will build and manage the neighborhood, were on hand along with Hunter-based service members and their families.

The new homes will offer three- and four-bedroom duplex and quadruplex floor-plan options with 2½ baths, large walk-in closets, ceiling fans, covered porches and two-car garages along with energy-efficient appliances, lighting and HVAC systems.

Two new playgrounds also will be built.

Hunter Ridge marks the last phase of new construction in what has been a multi-phased development and renovation project on the base. Since Balfour Beatty Communities assumed operations, 1,567 new homes have been built; 1,729 homes have been renovated and 946 old homes have been demolished.

Balfour Beatty Communities, LLC, a subsidiary of Balfour Beatty Capital Group, Inc., is responsible for the development, renovation, operation and

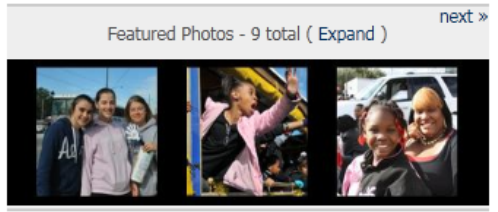
